*Fill in your holes and smush any sand creations before leaving the beach. These can create dangerous obstacles for turtles.

*Stay off sand dunes and use a boardwalk to reach the beach. Sand dunes (hills of grass) are a critical nesting habitat for turtles.

*Refrain from using lights at night on the beach. Lights can disorient turtles.

*Pick up trash. Sea turtles can mistake plastic litter for jellyfish.

*Keep dogs on a leash at all times.
