USDA Announces Final Rule for Conservation of Private Grazing Land Program

The 2002 Farm Bill authorized the U.S. Department of Agriculture to provide technical assistance from the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) to owners and managers of private grazing land through the Conservation of Private Grazing Land Program (CPGL). The final rule for the program was published in the Federal Register on Nov. 12.

"This is a voluntary program that addresses natural resource concerns on private grazing land while enhancing the economic and social stability of grazing land enterprises and the rural communities that depend on them," said South Carolina NRCS State Conservationist Walter W. Douglas. "This rule builds our capacity to provide technical assistance to those who own and operate private grazing land."

Through CPGL, NRCS conservationists will help individuals understand the basic ecological principals associated with managing their land and implement a conservation plan that meets their management objectives and the needs of the resources—soil, water, air, plants and animals.

NRCS technical assistance can help landowners maintain and improve private grazing land and its management, implement grazing land management technologies, protect and improve the quality and quantity of water, maintain and improve wildlife and fish habitat, enhance recreational opportunities, maintain and improve the aesthetic character of private grazing land, identify opportunities and encourage diversification, and encourage the use of sustainable grazing systems.

Although financial assistance is not available from CPGL, other federal, state and local programs may apply to grazing lands that provide financial assistance.

The 2002 Farm Bill represents an unprecedented investment in conservation on America's private lands—nearly \$13 billion over the next six years. USDA Seeks Comments on Farm and Ranch Lands Protection Program

The U.S. Department of Agriculture's Natural Resources Conservation Service is seeking public comments on the Farm and Ranch Lands Protection Program (FRPP), formerly known as the Farmland Protection Program (FPP). The 2002 Farm Bill amended the program and a proposed rule was published in the Federal Register on Oct. 29, 2002.

"While the name of the program has changed to more accurately reflect that both farms and ranches are eligible for assistance, the program's purpose, which is to protect prime, unique and important soil from conversion to nonagricultural uses through the purchase of conservation easements, remains the same," said South Carolina NRCS State Conservationist Walter W. Douglas.

The proposed rule establishes eligibility criteria, state ranking considerations and guidelines for program administration. USDA encourages written comments on the proposed rule from individuals as well as governmental agencies and non-governmental organizations during the 60-day comment period. Christmas Tree Growers Gear Up for the Holiday Season

Most South Carolina Christmas tree farms will be opening on Thanksgiving Day with expectations for a very busy weekend following the holiday. Some farms may open earlier this year because there are only three weekends before Christmas, instead of the usual four.

Each season, families pile into old pick-up trucks and take the time to drive out to a Christmas tree farm. Why? Because it's part of an age-old Christmas tradition!

"To me, with all the uncertainty of Iraq and terrorism; people are not cocooning themselves, but going back to more traditional things," said Chip Fink of Mystic Tree Farm in Greenville. "They want the traditional Christmas tree experience of going out, picking a tree, and cutting it down."

Fink also noted that bugs should not deter consumers from investing in a live Christmas tree, as many farms take measures to rid the trees of bugs.

Another primary reason that South Carolinians venture out to local Christmas tree farms is the high quality of the trees themselves. Locally grown Christmas trees are resilient and long lasting because they're fresher. Christmas tree choices in South Carolina include, Leyland Cypress, White Pine, Virginia Pine, Eastern Red Cedar, and Carolina Sapphire. Many tree farms offer a wide selection of fresh cut Fraser firs, which can rarely be grown in South Carolina because they require a colder climate to grow well. Most farms also provide a variety of fresh wreaths and garland.

Holiday Recipes

Dot's Sweet Potato Pecan Cheesecake

1, 6-oz. pkg. zwieback crackers, crushed
 5 eggs
 1/4 cup sugar
 6 tablespoons melted butter
 3, 8-oz. pkgs. softened cream cheese
 3/4 cups sugar
 3/4 cups packed light brown sugar
 2 cups cooked, mashed sweet potatoes
 1 teaspoon cinnamon
 1/2 teaspoon nutmeg
 1/4 teaspoon ginger
 1/3 cup heavy whipping cream
 pecan topping*
 whipped cream
 pecans

Directions: Blend zwieback crumbs, 1/4 cups sugar and butter in medium bowl. Press firmly over bottom and up sides of a lightly greased 9-in. spring form pan. Chill. Beat cream cheese in a large bowl with electric mixer at medium speed until smooth. Add sugars gradually, beating until well-mixed. Beat in eggs, one at a time, until light and fluffy. Beat in sweet potatoes, cinnamon,

nutmeg and ginger. Add heavy cream at slow speed. Pour into chilled crust. Bake at 325° for 1 hour and 35 min., remove cake from oven and sprinkle with pecan topping.

Bake an additional 10 minutes. Cool cake on wire rack. Refrigerate several hours. Garnish with whipped cream and pecans.

*Pecan topping: Combine 6 tablespoons softened butter with 1 cup packed light brown sugar in a small bowl; mix until crumbly. Blend in 1 cup coarsely chopped pecans.

Apple Dapple Cake

3 eggs
 1 1/2 cups salad oil
 2 cups sugar
 3 cups all-purpose Adluh flour
 1 teaspoon salt
 1 teaspoon soda
 1 teaspoon cinnamon
 2 teaspoons vanilla
 3 cups finely chopped SC apples
 1 1/2 cups chopped pecans

Mix eggs, salad oil and sugar and blend well. Add flour, salt, soda, and cinnamon and mix well. Add vanilla, chopped apples and nuts.

Put into greased 8 or 9-inch tube or bundt pan. Bake at 350 degrees for one hour. While cake is still hot, pour topping (below) over it in the pan.

Topping:
 1 cup brown sugar
 1/4 cup milk
 1 stick margarine (I use real butter)

Combine all ingredients and cook for 2 1/2 minutes. Pour hot topping from pan. Let set until cold; when completely cold, remove cake with topping from pan.

Sweet Potato Pie

1 1/2 cup cooked, mashed sweet potatoes
 1 egg
 1 cup sugar
 1/2 tsp. nutmeg
 1/2 lb. butter
 1/2 tsp. ground cinnamon
 1 cup evaporated milk

Combine all ingredients. Beat until light and fluffy. Pour into a 8 inch unbaked pie shell and bake at 350 degrees until knife stuck in the middle comes out clean.
