

Dear Ms. Vickery:

Thank you for your response to my letter. All Medical has also been serving Medicaid recipients through the state Medicaid program for over 12 years. That is exactly one reason that I do not believe Select Health should have the right to arbitrarily exclude us from serving the Medicaid recipients in your program. After all, as I previously pointed out, the funds are still taxpayer dollars, of which All Medical and its employees contribute.

Also, I would like to know what criteria you use in selecting your DME companies. I viewed the durable medical equipment suppliers that you have selected for Richland and Lexington Counties. None of these suppliers have Certified Assistive Technology Suppliers on staff and none have experience working with special needs children as All Medical does. By preventing qualified providers from participating in your plan you are creating a big disservice to your members and limiting the availability of services and technology to them.
