State road closures are down from a peak of **541** (Oct. 5) to **78** (Nov. 13), an **86 percent** decrease.

SCDOT Maintenance forces have led the majority of the repairs, including initiating 3 bridge replacement projects with in-house forces (see picture below).

24 highway/bridge contractors have been engaged to assist with 69 different “emergency/spot repairs” in 16 counties.

Contractors have also been engaged on 10 bridge replacement or major bridge/culvert repair projects in 4 counties.

Debris collected to date: approx. 1,635 loads (78,841 cubic yards)

18 of the remaining 78 road closures are expected to be re-opened by Thanksgiving.

9 primary routes remain closed.
