Could you or your office staff please provide me with a copy of any and all records, filings, or recordings of your orders or resolutions vesting either Original, Exclusive, or Concurrent Criminal Legislative Jurisdiction to the UNITED STATES in the case of UNITED STATES v. JAMES CHEEK, in case number 4:08-CR-873-002TLW. The records of which I am requesting would have been made between the dates of June 2008 and August 2009.

If you, as Governor Of South Carolina, did not issue any such orders or resolutions vesting any jurisdiction in the UNITED STATES in said case, then I would further request to be supplied with a copy of the NOTICE OF ACCEPTANCE OF JURISDICTION filed with your office by the UNITED STATES, pursuant to 40 USC §§ 3111-3112, or Article I, Section 8, Clause 17, of the UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION.
