Senator Alexander asked me to run this idea by you:

1. Have the bill signing at the Gignilliat Building of the Shaver Recreation Center in Seneca. It's a new facility and there will be a lot of children there participating in sports camps, etc. and he thought perhaps we could tie-in the Pulse Ox bill being able to detect if a heart is healthy...so children can grown up and play sports and go to camp without the worry of an unknown heart defect. We could have the kids playing on the play ground, or just a group standing around the bill signing....whatever you think we should do.
2. Coordinate a tour to the ITRON plant in Seneca which produces "smart meters" and are manufacturing items on the cutting edge of technology. The plant is 15 minutes away from the Gignilliat Building where the bill signing could be. Tour would be about one hour.
3. Is there any particular thing the Governor likes to do when she visits a community? He could arrange whatever she would like to do.
