I just want to clarify; if you already have a Health Savings Account (HSA), you do not need to re-enroll. **You can only have an HSA if you are enrolled in the State Health Plan Savings Plan.** If you are planning to switch from a different health plan to the State Health Plan Savings Plan, please be sure to contact me for an HSA enrollment form. Initial enrollment in an HSA is not automatic. Enrollment and re-enrollment in the MoneyPlus Medical Spending Account (MSA), Dependent Care Spending Account (DCSA), and the Limited-Use Medical Spending Account (limited-use MSA) is not automatic.

To participate in the MSA or limited-use MSA, you must be an active employee and, by Jan. 1, 2015, have worked full-time for one year for an employer participating in PEBA Insurance Benefits programs.
