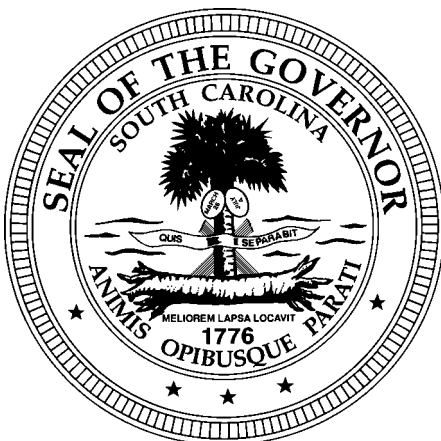
WHEREAS, critical care transport nurses continually strive to upgrade standards of practice and improve services to ensure that more lives are saved every day; and
