## National Corrections Reporting Program (NCRP) Data base Instructions

This is a Microsoft Access 97 database. The viewer may "find" and "filter" records. Be patient when searching: the database has nearly 200,000 records!

**Starting up the database:** Click on the 'Corrections' icon on the desktop to begin searching the database. You will see a display explaining the background of the NCRP files. Click on the box next to 'View Admissions/Discharges 1987-1994' to view the data.

The first record in the NCRP database will appear. You can read through the database one record at a time (See **Navigating in the database** below), but more likely you will want to either 'Find' a record or 'Filter' the database. For example, to search on only the *last name*, **Find** is recommended. If you have both a *first name* and *last name*, then use **Filter**. See below and Appendix A for further explanation of these two functions.

There will be a record for an admission and for discharge: some prisoners will have at least two records. The field names are abbreviated; however, at the bottom of the screen a brief explanation of a highlighted field and in some cases the code values will appear. Longer code sets are available in the documentation (See Appendix B).

### 1. **Navigating in the database:** use the arrows at the bottom left of the screen

- a. To move forward one record, use the right facing arrow
- b. To move to the end of the database, use the right arrow with the vertical line on the right
- c. To move back one record, use the left facing arrow
- d. To move to the beginning of the database, use the left arrow with the vertical line on the left.



### 2. **"Finding" records:** This function may be applied to one field at a time

- a. Locate and click on the field you wish to apply the find function to
- b. Click on the large binoculars at the top left of the screen
- c. The "find" box will appear. The default setting does not require case to be matched and will search both up and down the database. Do not modify these settings.
- d. Enter the information you want to search on and click on "Find first"
- e. The first record found will appear. A message will appear if no records can be located.
- f. Close the "Find Record" box



- g. To find the next record click on the small binoculars to the right of the large find binoculars. This is the "Find Next" function.



3. **"Filter by Forms"**. This function permits both "or" and "and" finding of records. A filter is a set of criteria applied to the database in order to show a subset of the database.

- a. Click on the "Filter by Form" Icon at the top of the page (looks like a paper form and a cone)
- b. A form with all fields blank will appear
- c. For "And" (i.e., white and female) enter the values in the appropriate fields (you will need to refer to the code tables)
- d. For "Or" (i.e., white or female) enter one value on the first display, then press the "or" tab at the bottom of the page and enter another value. Several "or" values may be entered.
- e. "Or" and "And" values may be combined in the same filter.



- f. Press the "Apply Filter" icon (a plain cone) to filter the records. If no records were found, a blank screen appears.



- g. After you have completed analyzing the results, press the "Remove Filter" icon (a cone with a red 'X' through it)

## Filter records by entering values in a blank view of your form or datasheet

- 1 Open a table, query, or form in Datasheet view or open a form in Form view.
- 2 Click **Filter By Form**  on the toolbar to switch to the Filter By Form window.
- 3 Click the field in which you want to specify the criteria that records must meet to be included in the filtered set of records.
- 4 Enter your criteria by selecting the value you're searching for from the list in the field (if the list includes field values), or by typing the value into the field.
  - To find records in which a check box, toggle button, or option button is or is not selected, click the check box or button until it's the way you want. To return it to a neutral position so that it won't be used as criteria for filtering records, continue clicking the check box or button until it's grayed.
  - To find records in which a particular field is empty or not empty, type **Is Null** or **Is Not Null** into the field. (You can select these options from the list in fields with a Memo, OLE Object, or Hyperlink data type, and in calculated fields in queries.)
  - To find records using a criteria expression, type the expression into the appropriate field or enter one using the Expression Builder. For examples of expressions, click .


If you specify values in more than one field, the filter returns records only if they contain the same values you specified in each of those fields.

- 5 To specify alternative values that records can have to be included in the filters results, click the **Or** tab at the bottom of the window, and enter more criteria.

The filter returns records if they have all the values specified on the **Look For** tab or all the values specified on the first **Or** tab or all the values specified on the second **Or** tab, and so on.

- 6 Click **Apply Filter**  on the toolbar.

### Notes

- When you save a table or form, Microsoft Access saves the filter. You can reapply the filter when you need it, the next time you open the table or form.
- When you save a query, Microsoft Access saves the filter, but it does not add the filter criteria to the query design grid. You can reapply the filter after you run the query, the next time you open it.

## About using wildcard characters to search for partial or matching values

You use wildcard characters as placeholders for other characters when you are specifying a value you want to find and you:

- Know only part of the value.
- Want to find values that start with a specific letter or match a certain pattern.

You can use the following characters in the Find and Replace dialog boxes, or in queries, commands, and expressions, to find such things as field values, records, or file names.

Character	Usage	Example
*	Matches any number of characters. It can be used as the first or last character in the character string.	<i>wh*</i> finds what, white, and why
?	Matches any single alphabetic character.	<i>B?ll</i> finds ball, bell, and bill
[ ]	Matches any single character within the brackets.	<i>B[ae]ll</i> finds ball and bell but not bill
!	Matches any character not in the brackets.	<i>b[!ae]ll</i> finds bill and bull but not bell
-	Matches any one of a range of characters. You must specify the range in ascending order (A to Z, not Z to A).	<i>b[a-c]d</i> finds bad, bbd, and bcd
#	Matches any single numeric character.	<i>1#3</i> finds 103, 113, 123

### Notes

- Wildcard characters are meant to be used with text data types, although you can sometimes use them successfully with other data types, such as dates, if you don't change the Regional Settings properties for these data types.
- When using wildcard characters to search for an asterisk (\*), question mark (?), number sign (#), opening bracket ([), or hyphen (-), you must enclose the item you're searching for in brackets. For example, to search for a question mark, type [?] in the Find dialog box. If you're searching for a hyphen and other characters simultaneously, place the hyphen before or after all the other characters inside the brackets. (However, if you have an exclamation point (!) after the opening bracket, place the hyphen after the exclamation point.) If you're searching for an exclamation point (!) or closing bracket (]), you don't need to enclose it in brackets.
- You can't search for the opening and closing brackets ([ ]) together because Microsoft Access interprets this combination as a zero-length string.
- If you're searching for values in a table other than a Microsoft Access table, such as a Microsoft SQL Server table, you may need to use different wildcard characters. Check the documentation for that data source for more information.

### Examples of expressions that use text values as criteria

Field	Expression	Description
ShipCity	"London"	Displays orders shipped to London.
ShipCity	"London" Or "Hedge End"	Uses the <u>Or</u> operator to display orders shipped to London or Hedge End.
ShippedDate	Between #1/5/95# And #1/10/95#	Uses the <u>Between...And</u> operator to display orders shipped no earlier than 5-Jan-95 and no later than 10-Jan-95.
ShippedDate	#2/2/95#	Displays orders shipped on 2-Feb-95.
ShipCountry	In("Canada", "UK")	Uses the <u>In</u> operator to display orders shipped to Canada or the UK.
ShipCountry	Not "USA"	Uses the <u>Not</u> operator to display orders shipped to countries other than the USA.
ShipName	Like "S*"	Orders shipped to customers whose name starts with the letter S.
CompanyName	>="N"	Displays orders shipped to companies whose name starts with the letters N through Z.
OrderID	Right([OrderID], 2)="99"	Uses the <u>Right</u> function to display orders with OrderID values ending in 99.
CompanyName	Len([CompanyName]) >Val(30)	Uses the <u>Len</u> and <u>Val</u> functions to display orders for companies whose name is more than 30 characters long.
