addresses what took place.

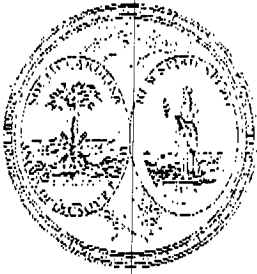
When Employees are covered up because

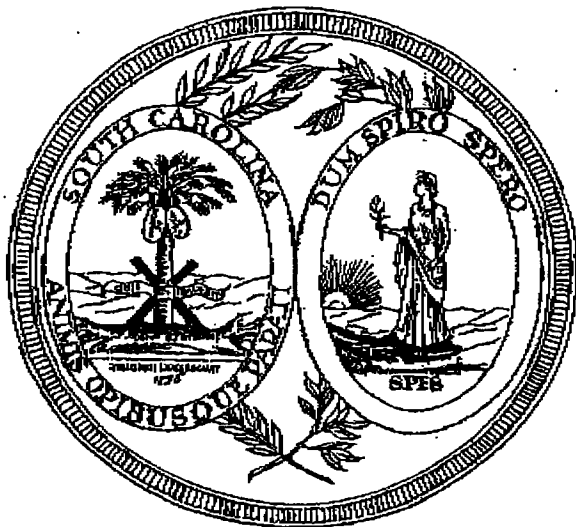

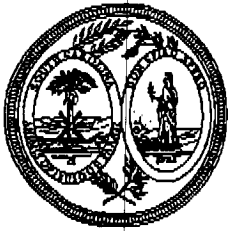
