FAMILY HISTORY

Deacon William (1868-1952) and Mrs. Annie Tobin Britt (1871-1948) were born in Saint George, South Carolina, located in Dorchester County. They were married and blessed with ten (10) children--six (6) girls and four (4) boys.

Deacon and Mrs. Britt were dedicated members of St. Mark Baptist Church in St. George, SC. Deacon Britt served on the Deacon Board at St. Mark for more than four (4) decades. He also served as Chairman of the Deacon Board for many years, and he served as Church School Superintendent and Church Class Leader. Mrs. Annie Britt served as Mother of the Church for many years. As a matter of fact, she was the Church Mother at the time of her death. She was known for making wine from blackberries picked from the fields to serve for communion. The bread served for communion was made from plain flour with no baking powder, just water and baked in the oven. The bread was broken into small pieces and served.

Deacon William and Mother Annie Britt were farmers in the Texas Community of St. George, SC for most of their lives. They were proud owners of many acres of fertile farm land, and the land still remains in the family. Deacon and Mother Britt were loved and respected by everyone in the community. Everyone in the community gathered at their house for Sugar Cane grinding and to see them rob the bees for honey. Though they were busy working the land and raising their children, they never neglected their duty to visit the sick in the community.

As we gather here today to celebrate our family reunion, let each of us keep in mind what our forefathers contributed to this community and let us continue their legacy. So do not be terrified or discouraged for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go.
