SECTION 1: The Minutes for the meeting of October 20, 2005; copies of which had been previously mailed to each member of the Commission, were approved.

SECTION 2: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving an amendment to the 2005 STIP, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

Surplus Property Public Notice

November 17, 2005

In accordance with the State of South Carolina Statue 57-5-340, by this publication the Department is making public the Surplus Property Real Estate Transactions to the State Highway Commission. The following sheets include a breakdown of surplus property real estate transactions. These transactions may have resulted from negotiations with property owners during right of way acquisition, direct sales, settlement of a condemnation action, and/or corrective actions to previously reported sales.

1. File 37.606 / US Route 76/123 / Oconee County / Third District

During construction of improvements on US Route 76/123, under File 37.448 in Oconee County, near the City of Westminster, the Department acquired right of way for US Route 123, by Condemnation from Louise D. Callaham, Guardian Ad Litem for minor, Wayne Callaham dated October 28, 1963, and by Deed to Right of Way from F. F. Wayne dated November 6, 1959, under Road S-64, File 37.302.

A request was received from the adjacent property owner asking the Department to sell a corner parcel of right of way. The request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.88 of an acre of land to Valenite, LLC was executed on September 21, 2005, in consideration of \$25,000.00.

2. File 32.691 / SC Route 12 / Lexington County / Second District

During construction of improvements on SC Route 12, under File 32.546.3/32.691 in Lexington County, near the City of West Columbia, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 12, by Title to Real Estate from Henry W. Odom dated August 28, 1973.

A request was received from the adjacent property owner asking the Department to sell a small piece of surplus property. The request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Departments needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.07 of an acre of land to Keith Bittle was executed on September 21, 2005, in consideration of \$500.00.

3. SCDOT Parking Lot / Park Street / Richland County / Second District

On November 13, 2003, the Department acquired approximately 3.93 acres of land, to be used for additional parking for the Department, from the City of Columbia.

The University of South Carolina requested to purchase the parking area bounded by Park Street, Green Street, College Street, and Lincoln Street. The Commission passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with the University of South Carolina transferring ownership of the parking lot in exchange for 350 parking spaces. The Budget and Control Board approved the sale. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed in the amount of \$1.00 and other valuable consideration for approximately 3.93 acres of land to the University of South Carolina was executed on September 21, 2005.

4. File 23.662 / US Route 276 / Greenville County / Fourth District

During construction of improvements on US Route 276, under File 23.662 in Greenville County, in the City of Greenville, the Department acquired right of way for US Route 276, by Title to Real Estate from Fannie Bell D. Allen dated July 8, 1975.

In the Department's efforts to liquidate its surplus inventory, the subject parcel was given to a real estate consultant to sell. This very small uneconomic parcel of land was offered to the public with the Grantee making a request to purchase. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for 0.028 of an acre of land to the City of Greenville was executed on September 8, 2005, in consideration of \$1,000.00.

5. File 23.246A / Route I-85 / Greenville County / Fourth District

During construction of improvements on SC Route 291 Relocation, under File 23.246A in Greenville County, near the City of Greenville, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 291, by Condemnation from T.C. Threatt dated November 16, 1993; under File 23.331 by Condemnation from Jerry H. Reaves dated August 17, 1951; by Deed to Right of Way from J. W. Cagle Estate dated August 8, 1951; and by Condemnation from J. W. Cagle Estate dated August 17, 1951, under the 291 Extension (Part 2).

In April of 2004 a quitclaim deed was executed at DEA Busbee's request. The Grantee passed away before he could complete the work he agreed to do in exchange for the right of way; therefore, the deed was never delivered to the Grantee. Since that time, his trustees have completed the work and are asking the Department to execute a new deed so it can be recorded in the Greenville County RMC Office. DEA Busbee has approved the work that was done. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.674 of an acre of land to Pamela Jay Threatt and Tommie Kay Caton, Successor Trustees under T. C. Threatt Living Trust was executed on September 26, 2005, in consideration of the original agreement made with T. C. Threatt.

6. File 39.622 / SC Route 135 Relocation / Pickens County / Third District

During construction of improvements on SC Route 135 Relocation, under File 39.622 in Pickens County, near the City of Easley, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 135 Relocation, by Title to Real Estate from Pickens County School District dated June 6, 1986.

A request was received from the adjacent property owner asking the Department to convey a piece of surplus property by the Relocation of SC Route 135. The request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.16 of an acre of land to Barnes Sheet Metal Inc. dba Easley Mechanical was executed on October 3, 2005, in consideration of \$6,600.00.

7. File 40.467A / Route I-26 / Richland County / Second District

During construction of improvements on Route I-26, under File 40.467A in Richland County, in the Town of Irmo, the Department acquired right of way for Route I-26 by Amended Condemnation Notice from Frances S. O'Tuel dated December 1, 1997, and recorded on December 2, 1997, in Book 1096 at Page 1886 in the RMC Office for Richland County.

At the request of Kent Lester, the adjacent landowner, a request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.46 of an acre of land was executed on October 3, 2005, in consideration of \$10,800.00 to Kent Lester.

EXTENSION OF CONTRACT BEYOND CONTRACT LIMITS

It is recommended that the Commission approve the extension of the following contract beyond the contract limits as follows:

Contract of BMCO Construction, Inc - File 22.619- extended to include an additional section of Project FAP BNH-WCCB(001) to include resurfacing on S-352 and S-86 for 1.05 mile.

Estimated Cost of Extension \$177,250.59

This extension is being requested in order to take advantage of lower unit prices available in this contract as opposed to other contracts currently available for extension in Georgetown County.

Removal of Roads From State Highway Secondary System

The Department recommends Commission approval for the removal of certain sections of secondary roads from the State Highway Secondary System. These sections of roads may be removed for one of the following reasons:

1. Abandonment of Relocated Section of Highway
2. Deletions and Removal of Roads from State Secondary System - Roads may be deleted and removed from secondary system by exchanging for equal or less mileage or roads, which have a higher traffic importance. Ownership reverts to local government having jurisdiction (city or county). Approval of deletion or removal by local government is not required.
3. Abandonment of Right-of-way - Right-of-way may be abandoned if it is determined that the right-of-way is not required for right-of-way proposes or if the right-of-way is not needed for Department purposes.
4. Court Order
