Description/Significant Features:

This resource is a small family cemetery measuring about 60x50 meters in size and situated in a lightly wooded pine/hardwood forest on a ridge toe. Graves are indicated by depressions, field stones, and inscribed stones. Only four burials have inscribed headstones. These are "William Peterson Born 178? Died 1868," "Anna Mangum Born May 20th 1765 Died April ? 1848," "William Mangum, Sr. 1827," and "Isabel Mangum Wife of William Mangum, Jr. Died July 13, 1823 Aged 23 Years." The site boundary was drawn based on elements of the cemetery visible on the ground as well as the landform. The boundary was drawn to give the fieldstones and depressions a buffer of about 25 feet.

Several old overgrown roads are present to the south and west.
This cemetery is also recorded as archaeological site 38NE1387.
