But the witness didn't make it to the court in time so he was found guilty.

But I pray that this matter can be looked into and may by some means and the grace of god he will be treated fair. not to plea bargain if he was not guilty  
he never had a chance, But because he

Guilty I'm not asking he be set free  
I'm asking if his sentence could be  
Looked into Right now he has 5 years  
to serve, then 20 more for the 3 witness  
that lied that is so unfair and unjust
