Subject: Social Security Has a New Service Available

Dear Colleague:

We are excited to announce that we have a new service available. Beginning today, Social Security beneficiaries can view and print their SSA-1099 and SSA-1042S online via their personal **my Social Security** accounts.

Tax season is here, and many beneficiaries need a SSA-1099 or a SSA-1042S to complete their tax returns. If your clients receive Social Security benefits and did not receive or misplaced their SSA-1099 or SSA-1042S, encourage them to save time and create a **my Social Security** account to get instant replacements.

Setting up an account is easy, secure, and convenient. Your clients just need to go to www.socialsecurity.gov/myaccount/. With a **my Social Security** account, they can:

- Get a **benefit verification letter**;
- Check their benefit and payment information and their earnings record;
- **Change their address** and phone number;
- **Start or change direct deposit** of their benefit payment; and now
- Get a replacement SSA-1099 or SSA-1042S.

We hope that you find this information helpful, and we encourage you to share it with your members and colleagues.
