Fellow Task Force Members,

Sorry to flood your inbox with information so close to our meeting tomorrow. I just received a massive amount of information this week. Melina and I have tried to go through all of it and categorize it so that you were only sent things relevant to your topic. To date, I have provided you three things:

- 1 – Copies of relevant state law in your notebook.
- 2 – A summary by topic of other state agency codes of conduct.
- 3 – And today, a summary by topic of state employee comments.
