### PRT Table Rock Fire update (7:00 Nov. 16)

The fire is moving fast. Tomorrow afternoon they will get aggressive and drop fire from the top and bottom of Table Rock mountain in an attempt to move the fire towards a firebreak. The goal is that the fires will meet, circle around the Stool (lower peak adjacent to Table Rock), burn upward on the Stool, and burn itself out. Friday will be the big day where we will know if this works.

Tonight the firebreaks are holding, and all necessary protection to our cabins and facility are in place. Fire companies from Greenville and Easley are staying in some of the cabins, with their Fire Engines and Tankers to guard the cabins.

Out of precaution, sprinklers are going on top the CCC Lodge roof that is made of wooden shakes. Hopefully by mid-day tomorrow both the cabins and the lodge will be out of danger. Cabins 15 and 16 (where you and detail have stayed) will probably get closest to the fire tomorrow. They are prepped with fire breaks.

A cold front is coming in on Saturday, so it's important to get this plan in action before expected winds.
