WHEREAS, from South Carolina's streets and highways to our schools and playgrounds, people are using their wireless phones to save lives, reduce crime, and promote safety everyday; and

WHEREAS, though wireless phones can help save lives, the wireless industry has put forth a strong effort to educate the American public in the importance of driving safely when using a wireless phone; and

WHEREAS, the 2001 observance of "Wireless Safety Week" provides a unique opportunity for the citizens of the Palmetto State to recognize the safety benefits of wireless phones, while working together to promote their safe use.
