Thank you for your letter of September 24, 2018, which we received on September 27, regarding the above referenced proposed undertaking. We also received a Section 106 Project Review Form, maps, and photographs as supporting documentation. The State Historic Preservation Office is providing comments to the South Carolina Army National Guard (SCARNG) pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act and its implementing regulations, 36 CFR 800. Consultation with the SHPO is not a substitution for consultation with Tribal Historic Preservation Offices, other Native American tribes, local governments, or the public.

The undertaking's Area of Potential Effect (APE) includes the Greenwood Armory (SHPO Site Number 0139), a property eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places. Based on the submitted information, our office concurs that no properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places will be adversely affected by this undertaking. We also concur that the Greenwood Motor Pool Storage Building (Quonset Hut) does not meet the criteria for listing in the National Register.

Our office recommends recording this resource as SHPO Site Number 0139.01 prior to demolition. We will forward you our draft revised Survey Manual separately as additional guidance.
