### S.C. apples to be harvested soon

The South Carolina apple harvest is just beginning, and this weekend Oconee County will hold its annual Apple Festival to celebrate the crop.

This year's apple crop will reap millions of delicious apples, in spite of some unfavorable weather this year. Bob McCurry, a marketing specialist for the S.C. Department of Agriculture, said the crop suffered a small set back due to hail damage, cool weather earlier this year and the recent drought, but the good news is that most of our state's apples survived the bad weather. And, as usual, the quality of our apples is only getting better.

"The apple crop should be of excellent quality this year," McCurry said.

To residents of Oconee County—also known as the Golden Corner of South Carolina and a place 75 apple growers call home—that's a reason to celebrate.

The festival begins on Monday, Sept. 6 at various locations in Westminster and Long Creek and continues to the weekend. Some of the week's highlights will include the Classic Road Race, the Westminster Rotary Club Golf Tournament, the Chattooga River Float and a Square Dance. On Friday, there will be arts and crafts on display, kiddie rides, a parade and other entertainment. On Friday evening the 8th Annual S.C. Apple Festival World Championship Rodeo will kick off.

Saturday's events include a tractor show, apple baking contest and the final evening of the rodeo.

South Carolina farmers grow many types of apples, including Red Delicious, Golden Delicious, Rome Beauty, Winesap and Granny Smith. Folks who miss the festival can always make a trip to the upstate to the many apple U-pick operations there. People travel from within and outside the state to pick our apples. ### S.C. food security liaison named

Dan Glickman, USDA Secretary of Agriculture, and Laurie C. Lawson, State Executive Director of the Farm Service Agency, have named Mack Greer Eubanks, Jr., as State Community Food Security Liaison for South Carolina.

As CFS Liaison, Eubanks will serve as a single point of contact and resource coordinator for all USDA-associated community food security and anti-hunger activities within the state.

The USDA Community Food Security Initiative, launched by Secretary Glickman earlier this year, is designed to create and expand grass-roots partnerships that build local food systems and reduce hunger. The USDA has joined with states, municipalities, nonprofit groups and the private sector to strengthen local food systems to fight hunger. As the State Community Food Security Liaison, Eubanks will coordinate food security programs within the state. He will also work with local nonprofit groups and government agencies to coordinate the state's participation in the National Summit on Community Food Security scheduled for October 15, 1999. ## Camden holds 1st horse festival

Camden, known internationally for its horse industry and home of the Carolina Cup and Colonial Cup, will hold its first festival celebrating the industry that's served the town so well.

The Come Horse Around Festival, sponsored by the Kershaw County Chamber of Commerce and Visitors Center, will showcase a trail ride and various equine demonstrations on Sept. 18 and 19.

Local organizers of the festival are excited there will finally be a celebration to honor Camden's horse industry. Camden is home to multiple breeds of horses and is one of the largest breeding spots for steeplechase horses.

"Almost every weekend there's something to do" within our horse industry, Dixie Hicks, president of the Chamber said.

Chamber officials—along with the South

Carolina Horsemen's Council—have been planning the event for two years.

"Hopefully, we'll have 10,000 people here for the festival," Hicks said. "We have a lot to see and do and a lot of animals."

On Saturday a Parade of Breeds will kick off the festival at 11 a.m., and other equine demonstrations will continue throughout the afternoon. Many food, drink, crafts and equine vendors will be set up in Camden's new revitalized downtown, and there will be pony rides and a petting zoo for kids.

The trail ride, to be held on Sunday and limited to 100 riders, will begin at 10 a.m. and end at 4 p.m. with a cocktail reception. The trail ride will cost \$40 per person, reception meal included. Cost for attending only the reception is \$15. For more information, call Hicks at (803) 432-2525.

### Commissioner's Column

#### Food Security for National Security

"Who cares if our farmers have had another drought disaster? Why should they receive assistance for losses? I could use assistance for my business, too."

I hear these kinds of statements from non-farmers over and over again. But the truth is that if anyone suffers losses from natural disasters, assistance is more often than not made available to all who are in need.

However, most non-agricultural business men and women don't depend on the weather to make a profit, so farmers have an especially difficult time with any natural disaster. Our farmers don't want assistance, but, sometimes, it's necessary to stay in business.

All of us should care about the plight of our farmers. If we eat one meal a day, live in a house and wear clothes made of natural fibers, we should care about agriculture. The fact is that we must have raw agricultural materials in South Carolina to entice industry to expand and develop here.

In addition to economic development, our national security depends on food security. We must continue to produce enough agricultural products for ourselves or we will have to depend on other nations for those products.

And, they don't have the same stringent rules and regulations governing production that we have, so we may not get the quality that we want from foreign products. Right now, we spend a little over 10 percent of our annual salary on food in the United States as opposed to 11.5 percent in the United Kingdom, 15.2 percent in France, 17.8 percent in Japan, 33.2 percent in Mexico and a whopping 51.4 percent in India.

Can you imagine spending over half of your yearly salary on food alone? It's true that we have the most affordable, most abundant and safest food supply in the world, but, at the same time, agriculture is suffering throughout the nation. More farmers are retiring, young farmers are opting for other careers, farm land is being encroached upon by urban and industrial development, prices to farmers are extremely low, crop protectants that are needed for production are being taken off the market arbitrarily and often without sound science, and natural disasters are taking their toll.

To help with the drought that our farmers have been experiencing, Governor Jim Hodges recently requested assistance from USDA Secretary Dan Glickman in Washington, and it was approved. But low-interest loans are only a temporary fix for some, so we must consider other ways to assist farmers in the long run. The trend for the future seems to be toward more dry, hot weather here in South Carolina, so we must plan now. As the Boy Scouts say, "Be Prepared."

I have been suggesting for quite some time that South Carolina, in cooperation with the federal government, develop a plan for irrigation like California and some other states have created. We have a tremendous amount of water resources throughout the state that can be used. Maybe if our farmers have access to irrigation, we can reduce the need for disaster assistance due to drought.

The answer that I give when people ask why farmers should receive disaster assistance is this: Everyone receives assistance whenever there is a disaster and whenever funds are available. Farmers and non-farmers who have experienced earthquakes, floods, hail, droughts, and hurricanes all over the country have received assistance from the federal government. In fact, with a much-anticipated, potentially devastating hurricane season before us, we should all be prepared for a disaster. As we learned from Hurricane Hugo in 1989, every person in the state can be affected by a natural disaster.

The National Hurricane Center has developed a hurricane preparation list of things to do if a hurricane heads our way. If you must evacuate, be sure to leave food and water or make other arrangements for your pets, turn off the gas and the electricity at the main breaker, close and lock the house, and take blankets, medicine, food and water for at least 24 hours.

As we prepare for the hurricane season, we must also prepare for the future of agriculture in this state. We must put our heads together and develop a way to keep our farmers farming. Also, when we learn that a drought has significantly affected the farmers of our state, let's try and understand that their needs are our needs. If they lose, we all lose.

#### Fresh Apple Croissants

Ingredients: Croissants—1 can (8 oz.) crescent rolls; 1 large cooking apple, peeled and cut into slices; 2 tablespoons sugar; 1 teaspoon cinnamon. Glaze—1/2 cup sugar; 1/2 cup half and half; 1 teaspoon almond extract, sprinkle of cinnamon, 1 egg, 1/2 cup sliced almonds, toasted.

Croissants—Combine sugar and cinnamon in small bowl. Separate dough in triangles and sprinkle with sugar mixture. Place a few apple slices on each triangle. Roll up and pinch ends of each crescent. Bake at 375 degrees for 15-20 minutes. Glaze—Combine first five ingredients in small bowl. Mix well. Drizzle glaze over crescents. Bake at 350 degrees 15-18 minutes. Cover with foil if croissants begin to get too brown. Makes 6 servings.
