

INVITATION FOR BIDS

The Housing Authority of the City of Columbia, S.C. will receive bids for the furnishing of all labor, materials, equipment and services required for electrical renovations to the following existing housing projects, Gonzales Gardens, Allen-Benedict, Hendley Homes and Saxon Homes. Columbia, S.C., until 10:00 A.M. D.S.T. on Tuesday, May 22, 1973 at the Central Office of the Authority, 1505 Garden Plaza, P.O. Box 4307, Columbia, S.C. 29204, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Proposed forms of contract documents, including plans and specifications, are on file at the office of the Housing Authority of the City of Columbia, and at the office of Holladay, Coleman, Williams & Assoc., Consulting Electrical Engineers, 3106 Devine St., Columbia, S.C., and at AGC and Dodge Plan Rooms in Columbia, S.C.

Copies of the documents may be obtained by electrical contractors by depositing \$25.00 at the office of the Engineers for each set of documents so obtained. Contractors who return drawings, specifications and other documents within ten (10) days after the bid opening will be refunded their full deposit.

A certified check or bank draft, payable to the Housing Authority of the City of Columbia, S.C., U.S. Government bonds, or a satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and acceptable sureties in an amount equal to five percent of the bid shall be submitted with each bid.

All bidders must have the statutory Bidder's and Contractor's Licenses. The successful bidder will be required to furnish and pay for satisfactory performance and payment bond or bonds.

Attention is called to the provisions for equal employment opportunity, and payment of not less than the minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the Specifications must be paid on this project.

The Housing Authority reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding.

No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of 30 days subsequent to the opening of bids without the consent of the Housing Authority.
