Description/Significant Features:

An early twentieth-century stone bridge abutment that carried a mining road across Hanna Creek. The bridge abutment consists of two random stacked stone walls with cement-covered faces along the creek bed. The bridge abutment has fallen into disrepair and the deck of the bridge is no longer extant. Although there is no longer a bridge crossing the creek, a 1966 USGS aerial photograph shows the creek and a roadway crossing it, at approximately the location of the Hannah Creek Bridge Abutment when the property was being used as a vermiculite mine.
