2002 Tobacco Market Openings Delayed

The USDA announced that the opening dates for the 2002 flue-cured tobacco auction sales have been delayed until July 30 for the southern region markets, July 31 for the eastern belt, and August 6 for the old belt in the northern region markets.

The southern region markets include the Georgia-Florida Belt and the South Carolina and border North Carolina Belt. The northern region markets include the eastern North Carolina Belt and the northern North Carolina and Virginia Old Belt.

Flue-cured tobacco auction sales were originally scheduled to open on July 23 in the southern region and July 24 in the northern region. These dates were recommended by the Flue-Cured Tobacco Advisory Committee on May 21 based on crop conditions at that time. As a result of drought and other unfavorable crop conditions, flue-cured tobacco will not be ready to market as originally anticipated.

Based on requests from various segments of the tobacco industry, the opening dates will be delayed to allow producers additional time to prepare their product for market. The delay will permit the tobacco industry to adjust to the crop conditions and allow the auction markets to open in a proper manner.

Beef Checkoff Collections Continue

A stay on the injunction to stop beef checkoff collections has been issued by the Eighth Circuit Court of Appeals. On June 21, 2002, a U.S. District Court Judge in South Dakota ruled that the Beef Promotion and Research Act is unconstitutional and ordered a halt to checkoff collections starting July 15th. But beef checkoff collections will continue while the case is being appealed.

The ruling means the \$1-per-head beef checkoff assessment will continue to be collected past the July 15th deadline and while the June 21st ruling is appealed.

The SC Beef Board has notified all livestock market collection points in the state to continue to collect and remit beef checkoff assessments as normal during the period that the stay remains in effect. Also, as done in the past, producers who sell cattle privately must also continue to remit the \$1 per head checkoff to the SC Beef Board using a Private Treaty Sales form. The form is available at Clemson Extension offices throughout the state or in the *Cattle Connection*, a publication produced cooperatively by the NC and SC Cattlemen's Associations. Upcoming remittances due by the 15th of August (July checkoff collections), but not received by the due date, will be treated in noncompliance. Late fees will accrue accordingly.

Commissioner's Column

Beef on the grill---beats the heat!

As the old saying goes, "if you can't take the heat---get out of the kitchen!"

To take some of the heat out of the kitchen and off of the cook these hot July days, families are heading outside. While consumers make every effort to keep cool, the beef is sizzling on the grill.

Lean beef can easily fit into a well-balanced diet. Beef is a nutrient dense food---one of the best dietary sources of protein, iron, zinc and B-vitamins. A single, 3-ounce serving of lean beef, the size recommended by most health organizations, contributes nearly half of the protein and zinc, over one-fourth of the iron and three-fourths of Vitamin B-12 of the recommended daily allowances for those nutrients, yet only 9% of the RDA for calories. Consumption of 5-7 ounces of cooked, lean beef (or other protein source) fits into the American Heart Association's recommendations for daily fat intake and for cholesterol.

As consumers, we play an important role in keeping our food safe from the time we put it in our grocery carts to the time we put it on the table. In fact, the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has found that improper food handling, either in the home or at restaurants, frequently contributes to reported food borne illness cases.

No one cares more about the safety of beef than cattle producers do. Raising safe beef is their way of life and their livelihood. South Carolina producers and others in the industry work hard to make sure that the beef you serve your family is nutritious and safe. But, because consumers are major players in keeping food safe, the South Carolina Beef Board through the check-off program has provided several steps that you can follow to keep your food safe.

For great grilled beef steaks and burgers at home, follow these tips.

- Choose the steak. Tender steak choices (top loin, top sirloin, ribeye, Porterhouse, T-Bone, tenderloin and chuck top blade) can be marinated briefly, if desired, prior to grilling to impart the marinade's flavor. Less tender steaks (top round, boneless chuck shoulder, skirt and flank) must be marinated in a tenderizing marinade at least 6 hours prior to grilling.
- Choose the ground beef. For juiciest burgers, choose 80% lean ground beef. Shape into patties using a light touch, otherwise burgers will be compact.
- Grill properly. Turn steaks with tongs. Do not use a fork, which pierces the beef and allows flavorful juices to escape. Turn beef patties with a spatula. Do not flatten them; flavorful juices can escape resulting in dry burgers.
- Cook to the correct doneness. Cooking times are based on beef removed directly from the refrigerator. Rare is 145°F; medium 160°F and well done is 170°F. An instant-read thermometer gives you the internal temperature immediately. Ground beef patties should be cooked to medium doneness (160°F) or until the centers are no longer pink and the juices show no pink color.

Always marinate in the refrigerator, never at room temperature. If a marinade is to be used later for basting or served as a sauce, reserve a portion of it before adding the beef. Marinade that has been in contact with uncooked meat must be brought to a full rolling boil before it can be used as a sauce. Never save and reuse a marinade. And, marinate in a food-safe plastic bag or non-reactive container.

Whether in the kitchen and at the grill, follow these four steps to fight bacteria and foodborne illness.

- Keep hands, counters, and utensils clean.
- Keep meats separated from other foods. Don't cross-contaminate.
- Cook to the proper temperatures.
- Refrigerate promptly after cooking.

Now, beat the heat! Get out of the kitchen! Have some fun and exercise outdoors with the family while the beef sizzles on the grill compliments of your South Carolina beef producers.
