Crop Adviser Workshop Scheduled at Santee

The Clemson Extension Service of Calhoun County and Clarendon County invite advisers and consultants who spend the majority of their time advising growers on agronomic practices to attend the Santee Certified Crop Adviser Workshop on November 20-22, 2002 at the Holiday Inn in Santee, SC at Exit 98 on I-95.

To be a Certified Crop Adviser, advisers and consultants must meet the requirements of the American Society of Agronomy's Certified Crop Adviser Program, the largest certification program in agriculture with over 14,000 certified throughout the US and Canada. In order to be certified program participants must pass two comprehensive exams and have at least 2 years experience with at least a Bachelor of Science Degree in Agriculture or 4 years experience with no degree. In addition, participants must document education and crop advising experience with transcripts and supporting references, sign and agree to uphold the CCACode of Ethics after certification, earn 40 hours of continuing education (CEUs) every two years, and pay an annual maintenance fee.

Russell Duncan, Clarendon County Extension Agent, and Charles Davis, Calhoun County Extension Agent, have geared the workshop to the four areas of competency that a CCA must complete---Nutrient Management, Soil and Water Management, Integrated Pest Management, and Crop Management.

With the topics to be covered at the workshop, each participant should be able to acquire many of the credits needed in each of the 4 competency areas necessary to be certified for the year. Those topics include: Soil Salinity, Alkalinity, & Related Soil & Water Analyses; Conventional Wisdom About Soil Texture Versus Reality; Conservation Tillage Systems for Soybeans; Irrigation Systems & Ground Water Situation; The Master Variable; Organic Matter: Wishful Thinking; and CCA/Commercial Applicator Equivalency; No-Till Liming Practices; Vegetable Fertility Issues; Overview of the Turfgrass Industry in SC; Turfgrass Fertility Management; The Southern Region Pest Management Center: A Resource; Revisions In the SC Fertilizer Law; Tobacco Issues; Third Party Vendors and NRCS; Wildlife Food Plot Weed Control Research; Insect Identification; Pesticides - Changes In The Field; Tomato Spotted Wilt Update; and Peanut Production Potential for SC. There will be something for everyone each day.

Clemson Extension Service, Natural Resources Conservation Service, Pioneer Seed Co., and Monsanto Company will provide all instruction. Reciprocal CCA CEU credits will be available for North Carolina and Georgia Certified Crop Advisers. In addition, workshop sponsors have applied for pesticide applicator recertification credits from those states and South Carolina.

The registration fee for the entire three-day workshop which includes class material, speaker handouts, refreshment breaks, and lunch each day is \$120 per person. A late fee of \$25 will be charged for registrations after November 1, 2002.

Commissioner's Column

Saving South Carolina Pines

What insect smaller than a grain of rice has cost South Carolina \$350 million? ---the southern pine beetle.

The southern pine beetle is a native insect of North and Central America and is a permanent resident of South Carolina. However, pine beetle epidemics occur from time to time when conditions are favorable. The state is currently in one of those epidemics.

According to the South Carolina Forestry Commission, the state's pine trees are dying by the millions, falling victim to the relentless assault of southern pine beetles. A Forestry Commission report places this year's loss as the highest ever recorded for a single year, claiming almost 27 million trees.

The southern pine beetle epidemic is an economic and environmental disaster of drastic proportions! Not only is the current pine beetle epidemic especially severe because of the state's long 5-year drought which makes trees more susceptible to infestations, but there's little or no market for the wood. Timber is just being left to rot on the forest floor.

The southern pine beetle epidemic is especially hard for private forestland owners, since three-fourths of South Carolina's timberland is owned by private citizens. Traditionally, timber has been an investment for educational purposes or as a supplement for retirement income. But, a beetle infestation can destroy a long-term, 30-year timber investment in only a few weeks.

Foresters say that the best way to stop a beetle attack is to cut and remove the infested trees. The next best thing to removal is to cut and leave the infested trees leaving a buffer zone of non-infested pine trees. The Forestry Commission has a cut-and-leave program that will help defray the cost of cutting down infested trees, but this program is not available for urban or developed areas or on commercial forestland.

To assist in this current pine beetle epidemic---the worst in South Carolina's history, the Forest Disaster Salvage Council has been reactivated to look for new ways to commercially harvest and market beetle-killed wood. In 1989, South Carolina foresters asked Governor Carroll Campbell to establish the Council to help with the forest devastation following Hurricane Hugo. In the mid-90s because of a southern pine beetle epidemic, the Council was reactivated by Governor David Beasley. And, now, once again, the Council has been reactivated by Governor Hodges to help in this critical epidemic situation.

The impact of this epidemic goes far beyond the loss of one of the state's most valuable natural resources. It goes beyond the millions of dollars lost. It goes beyond the damaged and dead trees that are fuel for wildfires and the loss of habitat for plants and animals. The real losers are those who depend on the forests for recreation and profit.

What can we do to reduce the risk of future southern pine beetle outbreaks? We can maintain good forest management or cultural practices to keep pine timber stands healthy and vigorous. We can continue to educate and inform forest owners about the southern pine beetle habits and symptoms and encourage them to seek the professional advice and assistance that is readily available.

In the business of agriculture, one bad apple can spoil the whole bunch by infecting the others. In the case of the southern pine beetle infestation, one infested pine can spoil a whole forest. With care and concern, we can and will, publicly and privately, individually and collectively, work together to salvage the unhealthy infested pines in order to save the healthy. If we can weather storms and droughts, we will not be defeated by this one tiny insect the size of a grain of rice.

If you are a forest landowner and want to help in the effort to save our pines, I urge you to call the South Carolina Forestry Commission, 803-896-8800. Your call can make the difference in whether South Carolina will be able to continue to have the resources necessary to battle this beetle!
