ON BACKGROUND: We have worked all year with the Senate and House to move ethics reform bills through the process to a conference committee so that they would survive past sine die (June 2). The Governor's major ethics reform initiatives have been the need for independent investigations of legislative ethics complaints and private income disclosure by public officials. H. 3186 and H. 3184 will accomplish that.
