I spoke with Catherine a little while ago, but thought I should email you as well with this request. I have worked for the past 10 years with a midlands youth leadership group of 9th and 10th graders along with Ted Riley and Scott Price. They do a legislative module each year and spend the morning doing mock subcommittee meetings in the Gressette Building on current legislation, usually meet for 15 minutes with the Governor or Lt. Governor, have a civics session, lunch at the Capitol City Club with legislators and then actually lobby their bill at the Statehouse.

We had scheduled to meet with Governor McMaster on the 24th at 10:30 for 10 or 15 minutes. Unfortunately with the snow and the postponement of the State of the State, he is no longer able to meet with us. We were hoping that Lt. Governor Bryant might be able to meet with the kids (around 35 along with Ted, Scott and me). It would just be a general conversation about how he leads now, his future goals to help lead in the state and what inspired him early on to lead. They may ask a few questions, but it would be pretty short. I'm hoping you all can help us out around 10:30 that morning. I apologize for the short notice and am appreciative of any help you can give us. The Lt. Governor's Office has always done a great job in past years with the group and it is the high point of the day.
