This bill just received 3rd reading in the Senate.

I heard back from DHEC – they are uncertain if more than one particular community would be affected by this bill; the analysis would require a lengthy, detailed study for each community. Therefore, it is unknown at this time if this bill applies to a class (constitutional) or to just one specific community (unconstitutional). Since DHEC could not rule out a class (manmade, predominantly armored, recreational use canals and essential access canals conveyed to the State or dedicated to the public between 1965 and 2016), then I suggest the bill is presumably constitutional. In addition, I was also told this bill clarifies a law that passed in 2011 and was signed by NH – Act 41 of 2011. Therefore, I would recommend signing the bill.
