Salaries of Teachers, including supervision and incidentals -	\$1,375.00
To Salaries of Director, Teachers' Certification	300.00
High School Supervisor	400.00
Supervisor of Agriculture	325.00
Supervisor of Trade & Industries	350.00

The following allocations were made from the Civil Contingent Fund:

The Sinking Fund Commission - \$250.00 - Telegraph and Telephone.

L. B. Wimberly - \$22.50 for special services as Court Stenographer

The Governor's Office - \$320.00 for repairs at the Mansion.

A request of the Board of Directors of the South Carolina Penitentiary
to be allowed to expend a portion of the Canteen funds for the construction of
a warehouse, for the purpose of storing certain Government supplies under terms
of a contract between the Federal Government and Major Boineau, was considered
by the Commission. The Secretary was directed to obtain all information with
respect to this application and submit it to the Commission at its next meeting.
