State Budget and Control Board

Fiscal year 1957-58

Columbia, South Carolina
July 31, 1957

The State Budget and Control Board met in the Governor's Office at 10:30 A. M., on Wednesday, July 31, 1957. All members of the Board were present.

The Board had for consideration a resolution of the State Ports Authority requesting approval for the issuance of \$6,000,000.00 in bonds as a part of the authorized \$21,000,000.00 Ports improvement program.

On motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Brown, the Board gave its approval to the request.

On motion of Mr. Rhodes, the Board agreed to supply from the Civil Contingent Fund the sum of \$8,000.00 to cover the expense of the Tax Study Committee.

The Board agreed to pay the Insurance bill of the Confederate Home building from the Civil Contingent Fund.

The Board deferred action on the payment of attorney fees in connection with the Clarendon County School case.

The Board authorized payment of bills held by the State Auditor to the Southern Regional Education Board for the year 1956-57.

The Board authorized the payment from the 1956-57 Civil Contingent Fund to cover a deficiency of the Juvenile Placement Division of the Industrial Schools Board, in the amount of \$386.72.

The Board directed the Mental Health Commission to pay from the Pinewood maintenance appropriation, the cost of extending the septic tank tile field, in the amount of \$2,370.00.

The Board declined to provide funds from the Civil Contingent Fund to contribute toward the purchase of band uniforms for the Clemson College Band.

The Board referred back to the Chief Justice his request for approval of salary increases for Judges Bellinger and Pruitt.

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The Board approved a \$1,200.00 salary increase for the Superintendent of the S. C. Sanatorium.

The Board approved a salary of \$13,500.00 for the President of Clemson College.

The Board approved a salary of \$10,000.00 for the State Director of Public Welfare.

The Board reconsidered its last meeting decision in disapproving the construction of a house for the Vice President for Development at Clemson College, and approved the construction of same at a cost not to exceed \$40,000.00.

The Board agreed to supply to Clemson College up to \$5,000.00 from the Civil Contingent Fund to apply to the cost of equipment to be used in the Neuclear Energy Program at the College.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned.

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
