Construction continues to progress as scheduled with the development and grading of the manufacturing campus. [The manufacturing building pad](#) is ready for the construction of the new facility. The Anderson County Office of Economic Development has taken the lead in prioritizing the Arthrex site and facilities design review, helping us obtain permits for commercial land use, storm water management and wastewater. We appreciate their knowledge and assistance. The Anderson County Building Department has issued building permits for our manufacturing and central services facilities. Utility design review continues and construction has begun.

We're excited to introduce you to **Aaron Wilson**, the future director of operations at AMISC, currently in the same position at Arthrex Manufacturing Inc. in Ave Maria, Florida.
