A special meeting of County Council of Charleston County was held on the 2nd day of January, 2014, in the Beverly T. Craven Council Chambers, Second Floor of the Lonnie Hamilton, III Public Services Building, located at 4045 Bridge View Drive, Charleston, South Carolina.

Present at the meeting were the following members of Council: Teddie E. Pryor, Sr., Chairman, who presided; Colleen Condon; Henry E. Darby; Anna Johnson; Joseph K. Qualey; A. Victor Rawl; Herbert R. Sass, III; Dickie Schweers and J. Elliott Summey.

Also present were: W. Kurt Taylor, County Administrator and County Attorney Joseph Dawson.

The Clerk reported that in compliance with the Freedom of Information Act, notice of meetings and agendas were furnished to all news media and persons requesting notification.

Mr. Summey nominated Mr. Pryor as Chairman of Charleston County Council for 2014. The motion was seconded by Mr. Darby and carried. Mr. Qualey voted nay and Mr. Schweers abstained.

Mr. Darby nominated Mr. Summey as Vice Chairman of Charleston County Council for 2014. The motion was seconded by Ms. Johnson and carried. Mr. Schweers abstained.

Chairman Pryor thanked the other members of Council for electing him to leadership for a sixth term. The Chairman stated that in response to requests from other members of Council regarding the practice of making appointments to boards and commissions he would like to add an item to the next Administration Policy/Rules Committee agenda to consider allowing all members of Council to participate in the Administration Policy/Rules Committee for the purpose of making appointments to boards and commissions.
