

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CERTIFICATE OF TRANSMITTAL

The certificate of transmittal serves three functions. First, it documents the transmittal of criminal charging papers and related documents from the summary court to clerks of court. Second, it documents the receipt by the clerk of the listed criminal papers. A third and optional function is to inform the solicitor of the transmittal to and receipt of such papers by the clerk. Throughout the following instructions, all references to warrants should be understood to include uniform traffic tickets issued for general sessions offenses.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MAGISTRATES AND MUNICIPAL JUDGES

Your use of this form is normally initiated in the summary courts when (1) a recently served general sessions arrest warrant is being sent to the clerk of court for the first time, and, (2) follow-up on paperwork (bond form, etc) relating to that arrest warrant is being sent separately to the clerk. Rule 3 of the Rules of Criminal Procedure requires that the summary court judge forward all documents pertaining to the case including, but not limited to, the arrest warrant and bond, within fifteen (15) days from the date of arrest in the case of an arrest warrant and date of issuance in the case of other documents. For each warrant transmitted, indicate yes or no as to whether it was, prior to transmittal, dismissed at a preliminary hearing. In every instance, the information at the top right (page _____ of _____ pages, county, etc.) must be completed. The Magistrate who completes the form and transmits the Certificate of Transmittal must also insert their personal judge code in the blocks provided.

Warrants being sent to the clerk for the first time should be listed with careful attention given to legible and correct spelling of the defendant's name, date of arrest and the warrant or ticket number. If other items (bond, check lists, etc), are included, check the appropriate boxes.

Whenever the warrant has already been sent to the clerk but related documents such as bond forms, checklists, etc., are following, the name and warrant number must be completed and the appropriate box(es) checked. In this instance, the absence of the original warrant (already previously transmitted) is indicated by the warrant box not being checked.

Upon completion of the form, the canary copy is retained by the transmitting official and the remaining copies are sent to the clerk.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLERKS OF COURT

Rule 3 of the South Carolina Rules of Criminal Procedure requires the clerk of court to forward a copy of any arrest warrants received from the summary court to the solicitor within two (2) business days from date of receipt from the issuing official. Similarly, upon request, a copy of the warrant must be provided to the summary court judge for the purpose of conducting a preliminary hearing. This form is used to document which warrants have been sent up from a summary court, it also (1) documents which warrants have been received by the clerk and the date of receipt and (2) serves to inform the solicitor of the details of active warrants and other papers on file with the clerk and record when the clerk transmitted the copies of the warrants to the solicitor.

Upon receipt of an original warrant that was dismissed at a preliminary hearing before its transmittal to you, initiate and simultaneously end the docket sheet by sending SCCA the green and gold copies. Send the pink copy to the solicitor. Do not send the solicitor a copy of the dismissed warrant. Certified copies of warrants returned to you after a preliminary hearing should be filed with the original warrant.

Upon receiving the certificate and verifying that all warrants listed on the certificate are attached, the section at the bottom left should be completed and the white copy retained. Within two (2) business days from the clerk's receipt of the certificate, the pink copy of the certificate should be sent to the solicitor if the solicitor has requested that he receive copies of all certificates of transmittal. If not, the pink copy can be discarded.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SOLICITORS (OPTIONAL)

This certificate may also serve as a communication device between the summary courts, the clerk and the solicitor. It can also serve to document compliance with Rule 3 of the South Carolina Rules of Criminal Procedure. Upon receipt of the pink copy of the certificate, you can initial and date the document in the space provided at the bottom right and retain for your records.
