
Dear Historical Commission Members:

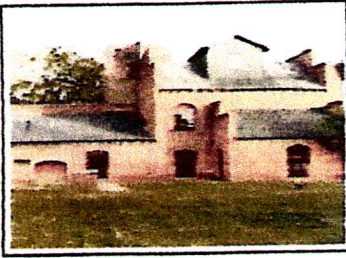
