Team,

My apologies for the email on this day of rest, but I wanted to share a short memo related to the Paris terrorist attacks and the potential impact on SC. While national security is primarily a federal issue, I see at least two areas of SC policy that may come under additional scrutiny in the wake of the attack: 1) refugee resettlement, and 2) homeland security. The attached brief memo provides basic reported facts on the attack, a short overview of the two SC policy areas that may be scrutinized, and two rather minor suggestions of things we can do to make sure we are responding appropriately to the increased threat environment.

Happy to discuss further when the time warrants, but, for what it's worth, I wanted to make y'all aware of these initial thoughts.
