Governor's Proclamation

WHEREAS, Central Service Technicians are trained medical support workers responsible for processing surgical instruments, supplies, and equipment in settings ranging from hospitals to ambulatory surgical centers; and

WHEREAS, tasks within the Central Service Department of a healthcare facility include decontaminating, cleaning, processing, assembling, sterilizing, storing, and distributing the medical devices and supplies required for operating rooms, Endoscopy suites, ICU, birth centers, and other patient care areas; and

WHEREAS, working as part of a healthcare team, Central Service Technicians play an important role in patient care arenas and are responsible for first-line processes to prevent patient infections; and

WHEREAS, the 2014 observance of Central Service Technicians Week honors these professionals for their dedication to patient safety and raises awareness of the opportunities and challenges facing the profession.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim October 12 - 18, 2014, as
