Because your concern is legal in nature, it is under the authority of the court system and outside of my official jurisdiction as a legislator. Therefore, it would be inappropriate for me to intervene. Under the Constitution, pardon authority is only granted to the Executive branch. In your situation, that would be the Governor's office.
