

Rationale for Discontinuation of Academic Affairs Reports

1. Annual Report on Centers, Bureaus, and Institutes: information on these entities will now be included in existing program reviews by discipline area.
2. Summary Report on Program Modifications: this report has been given for informational purposes only and can be done orally if requested or placed on the CHE website.
3. Report on Institutional Offerings via SCETV: this report has been given for informational purposes only; ETV and the colleges and universities can provide this information as needed.
4. Two-Year Mid-point Evaluation of Centers of Excellence: this report is not required by law; interim written reports submitted by the Centers will suffice for obtaining needed information.
5. Report on Teacher Education Critical Shortage Areas: this report has been given for informational purposes only and its contents can be placed on CHE website; also, deans of education at the colleges and universities already receive this information.
6. Follow-up Report on Low Productivity Programs: information contained in this report can be folded into the existing program review process; this information is to be used as part of Performance Indicator 1.B, Curricula Offered to Achieve Mission.
7. Offsite Course Offerings Report: this report has been made for informational purposes only; information used in the report will continue to be collected as part of the agency's CHEMIS system and can be reported on an as-needed basis. This information will be incorporated under Performance Indicator 8.C, User Friendliness of Institution, part b.
8. Report on Cooperation Between USC Regional Campuses and Technical Colleges: information contained in this report has been subsumed under Performance Indicator 4A, Institutional Cooperation and Collaboration.
