Single-Block Commercial building. It is of concrete block construction with brick veneer on the front elevation and overhanging boxed eaves. The front elevation of the historic core is largely symmetrical with a central modern wood half-light door flanked by fixed picture windows. The southern picture window has been filled in with stucco. A flat aluminum awning shelters the full front elevation and is suspended from the roofline by slender metal posts.

Alterations (including date(s), if known):

Two historic additions have been made to the rear of the building in concrete block, one front-gabled and one shed-roofed. A large modern addition has also been made to the

south elevation of the building. It is clad in V-crimp metal siding, has a laterally gabled composition shingle roof, and more than doubles the size of the building.
