Description/Significant Features:

The Woods Ferry Picnic Shelter is of open design consisting of two sidewalk connected structures built of stone, timber, and wood frame construction. US Forest Service records indicate that the connected picnic structures were constructed in 1964 at the same time as the bath house in Loop B. Specific dimensions of the construction elements of the structure are presented in Figures. The Woods Ferry picnic shelter measures approximately 64 feet in length by 20 feet in width and is 12 feet in height to the top of the roof. The roof has a two-foot overhang and a three by ten-inch rafter. The building is a single-story open-air timber structure with masonry stone floor.
