WHEREAS, sound urban and regional planning contributes to the quality and livability of our communities and environment, addressing both current and future needs; and

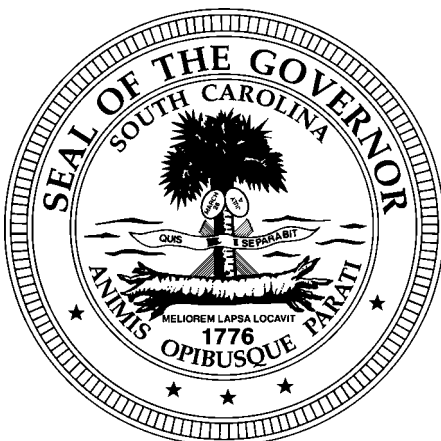
