Commissioner's Column

**Paso Fino---
a "fine step" for Creighton Shull's Farm**

The Shull name is synonymous with agriculture in the Midlands of South Carolina. True to his heritage, Creighton Shull is known for his God-given talent for growing and raising everything from plants to Paso Finos. But, his greatest asset is his positive attitude and his endearing wit and charm.

I've known Creighton and his family for many years. He has 5 children, 13 grandchildren, and 4 great grandchildren. "They just call me 'The Great'," he said. He has a real passion for spreading joy. In addition to his agribusiness success, his efforts as a magician and ventriloquist have delighted audiences all over the state.

The land on which Creighton's landscaping and retail nursery business and his horse stables and pastures reside has been in the Shull family for over 200 years. Right in the heart of West Columbia, his farm is convenient to surrounding rural and urban areas---only minutes away from the city.

While Creighton has been in the landscaping and nursery business for 47 years, his passion is Paso Finos. Even though he has 17 Paso Finos, Creighton said he's no longer concerned about winning ribbons and trophies with his horses. He has an office filled with awards and accolades. Nowadays, he's just concerned about winning the hearts of children. Whether it's nurturing a plant or a horse, he wants to instill in children his love for growing. It's these children that will grow up and take over where we leave off, so we must teach them that agriculture---every aspect of this down-to-earth business---is an important part of their existence---of their future.

In order to promote the Paso Fino breed, Creighton is hosting an Open House free to the public on Saturday, May 4, 2002, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. at his farm on Ermine Road in West Columbia. The Pure Puerto Rican Paso Fino Federation (PPRPFF), established in 1987 with the sole purpose of preserving the "four beat lateral gait," holds Open House each spring on farms throughout the East Coast. As one of the founders of the Federation and a Paso Fino advocate for the last 15 years, Creighton continues to breed and sell these horses throughout South Carolina and neighboring states, making new friends with each sale. I invite you and your family and friends to attend Creighton's Open House to see these beautiful even-tempered, smooth-riding Paso Finos. You may even have the opportunity to ride one.

Creighton describes the Paso Fino as the smoothest ride in the world, "the Cadillac of the horse world". In fact, the Bishop's wife from the United Methodist Church of which Creighton is a devoted member recently rode one of the horses at his farm. He said she described riding the Paso Fino as "the next best thing to doing the Lord's work."

Literally translated, "Paso Fino" means fine step. Born with a four-beat lateral gait creating a rapid, unbroken rhythm, the Paso Fino's step is smooth and rhythmic. The horse's body acts as a shock absorber, so the rider feels no bounce and sits smoothly in the saddle gliding along. Paso Finos can lope, canter, or gallop, and they can be trained to do formal dressage, or anything that other breeds can be trained to do. But the natural four beat lateral gait is the preferred movement.

**SC Livestock
Producers Eligible for
CRP Riparian Buffers**

The South Carolina USDA Farm Service Agency announces that livestock producers may be eligible for riparian buffers under the Continuous Conservation Reserve Program (CRP).

A riparian buffer for marginal pastureland purposes is a strip of trees planted next to a permanent or seasonal stream corridor or other waterbodies of a permanent nature that discharge water off the farm. The purpose of the riparian buffer is to remove nutrients, sediment, and other pollutants from surface runoff.

Marginal pastureland that is located next to a permanent or seasonal stream corridor or other permanent waterbodies may be eligible under the Continuous CRP Signup.

Producers who are approved CRP contracts for riparian buffers will receive an annual rental payment for the approved acreage for a 10 to 15 year period. In addition, cost-share assistance is available for establishing the trees, required fencing, water facilities and drilling wells if needed for alternate livestock water. Approved CRP contracts for riparian buffers will receive a signup bonus of \$100 to \$150 an acre and a practice incentive bonus.
