Subject: Update: Refugee Data

This morning, I received the data for the period of October 1, 2015, to March 31, 2016, from the Department of State regarding refugee resettlement. In this period of time, 101 refugees have been resettled in the state. The refugees are from 9 different counties of origin. The documentation confirms that in this federal fiscal year, still only 2 individuals of Syrian national origin have been resettled in the state. Two other data points that may be helpful are that of the refugees resettled in this period, 37 are between the ages of 0-17 years old and 48 are females.
