I, James Najee Karim, one of the People of South Carolina republic and in this court of record complain that N W MAXWELL acted in excess of jurisdiction - CORAM NON JUDICE. This is a claim of vindictive prosecution and usurpation of power. Mr. Karim brings this claim under state evidence code for proof of scope certification and decree the Constitution of the United States and the South Carolina Constitution as the law of this at law action. This action is to require the Defendants to obey the rule of law.

Personal jurisdiction is lacking. On 26 Feb 2016, N W MAXWELL arrested Mr. Karim, per Ticket # H 529198, without a warrant supported by oath or affirmation as guaranteed by the South Carolina Constitution at Article 1 section 10. MAXWELL took an oath to "preserve, protect and defend the Constitution of this State and of the United States" and he has failed to do so. During this unlawful contact, Mr. Karim feared for his life because in recent months, South Carolina "law enforcement officers" have committed murder for traffic infractions. On 13 Oct 2015 Mr. Karim went before TRAFFIC COURT in Lexington County under Ticket #: H 437497 protesting another warrantless arrest. That case was dismissed and is therefore precedent setting. This case is both malicious and double jeopardy in violation of SC Constitution Article 1 section 12.

The relief Mr. Karim seeks is immediate dismissal of this case with prejudice, expungement from all public access and compensatory damages in the amount of \$1,000 for lost wages and expenses incurred in defending this action. Mr. Karim demands acknowledgement on or before 24 Mar 2016 that this case has been dismissed else on 28 Mar 2016 Mr. Karim will remove this case to the SC Supreme Court to correct this procedural error. Mr. Karim does understand that the federal Supreme Court has original jurisdiction over all cases where a state is a party. However, Mr. Karim is giving this court the opportunity to correct its own error.

I declare under penalties of perjury that everything stated herein is true, correct, complete and not meant to mislead to the best of my knowledge and belief.
