The State Budget and Control Board met in the office of the Governor on Thursday, April 19, at 3:30 P. M. All members of the Board were present except Mr. Rhodes.

Offers of prospective buyers to purchase the R. E. A. building were postponed due to the absence of Mr. Rhodes.

An offer of Mr. W. F. Clarke to purchase 331 acres of land known as Big Horse Pen Bay in Marion County for the sum of \$1,800.00 was rejected by the Board. The Director of the Property Division was authorized to advertise and offer this property for sale at auction on Sales Day, Monday, June 4, 1951, at the Marion County Court House.

The Director of the Property Division was authorized to consult an architect with the view of repairing and renovating the Caughman Building.

The Director of the Property Division was authorized to have installed suitable lights at the northern entrance of the Capitol Building.

A number of appropriation transfers were approved by the Board. The Secretary was authorized to approve such transfers without submission to the Board except when, in his opinion, it was deemed advisable to do so.

The Secretary was directed to advise the State Superintendent of Education that no further funds would be supplied from the Civil Contingent Fund for the investigation of teachers' examinations after the end of the present fiscal year.

Upon application from the Board of Visitors of The Citadel, the Board authorized the salary of the President to be fixed at \$10,000.00 per year effective March 1, 1951.
