In your busy time I hope  
you can find relief for my  
situation, I am 66 years old and  
have worked all my life except  
the past fifteen years and have  
been turned down for disability  
5 times, because they say for not

enough credits. I mean really, because the last year I didn't work the whole year.

I have had four back back surgeries, practically my whole back is titanium, and also 3 neck surgeries, right hip replacement and have disc degenerative disease osteopenia arthritis. Mam I live a very fragile life now and with a husband who is not happy at all with how our past sixteen years of marriage have turned out so I live under the cloud of any day my husband could leave me. My single wide mobil home I live in is paid for by my inheritance I received from my Grandma who I took care of the last four years of her and my grandfathers life. They paid me a total 200. dollars a week and I cleaned three

different homes every weekend  
for 35. dollars a home not taxed.  
and the four years before that  
I took care of the Plexico family  
for 200 dollars taxed a week where  
I cleaned house, laundry, ironing  
picked up kids (2) from school  
and cooked supper when I lived  
in Barnwell, S.C. and before  
those four years I was a waitress  
in Nashville, Tenn., Paducah, Ken.,  
Houston, Tex, Holiday Inns (2)  
in Charleston, S.C. The others  
were also Holiday Inns but the  
one in ~~Houston~~ was Marriott. I  
was an excellent waitress and also  
in charge of dining room reservation  
channers also. I also worked  
in three different sewing rooms in  
S.C., a Ricoh tape assembler  
in Summerville S.C. and always  
had house cleaning jobs under the  
table which I'm now sorry I did  
that but those were measures taken

by a single woman for twenty  
years after a tortured marriage  
with my second husband of four  
years.

I know my reason is not enough  
credits on the last year I worked but

generally I think that is a big  
ingratitude to me for all the years  
I worked so hard and now I'm in

the position where I only get 110. dollars  
a month S.S. w/medicare and I'm  
very Thank. for that.

Please whenever they help me  
get my disability, unlike so many  
I worked my hard for it and back  
and neck problem one my neck.

Please help me take care of myself  
for my remaining years.
