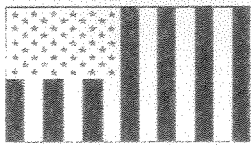

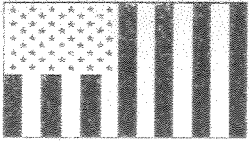
NOTICE OF ESTOPPLE AND STIPULATION OF CONSTITUTIONAL CHALLENGE TO ALL SOUTH CAROLINA STATE STAUTUES WHERE Every citizen of this State owes paramount allegiance to the Constitution and Government of the United States, and *no law or ordinance of this State* in contravention or subversion thereof can have binding force; **AND MOTION TO INTERVENE WITH AN INJUNCTION FOR NAME RILEY ROY KAREEM d/b/a ROY KAREEM RILEY & NOTICE THAT RILEY ROY KAREEM d/b/a ROY KAREEM RILEY registered agent of entity is Secretary of State of Pennsylvania as its agent upon whom a Notice of Claim against the public corporation may be served.**

TAKE NOTICE THAT *pursuant to 1789 Constitution of the United States of America (as ratified without subsequent amendments)* and 1789 Bill of Rights; Amendment X. The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the states, are reserved to the states respectively, or to the people.;

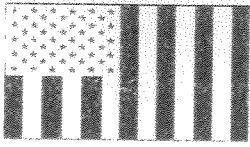

AND TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT pursuant to 1868 South Carolina Constitution (as ratified without subsequent amendments) **ARTICLE I. DECLARATION OF RIGHTS. SECTION XIV** No person shall be arrested, imprisoned, despoiled or dispossessed of his property, immunities or privileges, put out of the protection of the law, exiled or deprived of his life, liberty or estate, but by the judgment of his peers or the law of the land. And General Assembly shall not enact any law that shall subject any person to punishment without trial by jury; nor shall he be punished but by virtue of a law already established, or promulgated prior to the offence, and legally applied.

AND TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT the material facts giving rise to the constitutional questions are as follows:

1. *unalienable rights, protected by 1868 South Carolina Constitution and 1868 DECLARATION OF RIGHTS, right of travel has been violated; in the past*
2. *unalienable rights, protected by 1868 South Carolina Constitution (as without subsequent amendments and 1868 DECLARATION OF RIGHTS, federal government contracting with a minor has been violated.*
3. *unalienable rights, were violated protected by 1868 South Carolina Constitution (as without subsequent amendments and 1868 DECLARATION OF RIGHTS, SECTION XXII All persons have a right to secure from unreasonable search or seizures of their persons, house, papers or possessions. All warrants shall be supported by oath or affirmation, and the order of the warrant to a civil officer to make search or seizure in suspected places, or to arrest one or more suspected persons, or to seize their property, shall be accompanied with a special designation of the person or objects of search, arrest or seizure; and no warrant shall be issued but in the cases and with the formalities prescribed by the laws. Violated in the past.*
4. *unalienable rights, were violated protected by 1868 South Carolina Constitution (as without subsequent amendments and 1868 DECLARATION OF RIGHTS SECTION XXIII: private*
