

Trout of Southern Appalachia

Trout are found in mountain streams and lakes throughout Southern Appalachia. These aquatic habitats provide cold, clear, oxygen-rich water required for trout to survive.



Brook Trout, *Ictalurus nebulosus*, is the only trout native to Southern Appalachia. They are often called "speck" because of the spots, blue-black spots and spots on their lower bodies. Trout have two air and backbone with black stripes and a reddish edge of white.

The **Rainbow Trout**, *Oncorhynchus mykiss*, is the most adaptable of North American salmonids. They are found in many streams, lakes, and rivers. They are found in both high-altitude streams and low-altitude streams.

The **Striped Trout**, *Morone chrysops*, is a species of Atlantic. The fish was first introduced to the United States in 1862. Striped trout is a common species and has been introduced to many streams with only a few edge of white.
