Chaney, good to chat this morning. For the Convention, we've got 2 events and we'd love to have the Governor appear at either one.

Both are at the **Blue Point Grille**, 700 W St Clair Ave, Cleveland and are led by Atlantic journalists.

Tuesday 7/19 starting around 4:45 in the afternoon, for about 1/2 an hour or so, is an event with Refinery 29, to talk about millennial women's role in society and politics. We'd like to hear from the Governor in an on-stage conversation about her role as a leader and role model for young women and how she thinks young women should get involved in public affairs and politics.

The other event is Thursday 7/21 starting around noon -- called Pathways to Power -- a lunch sponsored by Running Start, She Should Run and All in Together. That would be a short conversation about her path to power and her advice for women and other groups underrepresented in politics to get involved, either by running for office or staffing people who do. We'd also like to hear from her about her role as the state's executive and how she's become one of only a few women to reach the Governor's mansion.

Please let me know if she's interested and available to attend either event. We can be flexible on her timing and would love to have her appear for whatever amount of time she is available.
