#### **VOTING BACKGROUND:**

- ☐ 2014 Chairman of the House Freshmen Caucus and has helped with communications to the Freshman Caucus and disseminating information from our office.
- ☐ Supports ethics reform
- ☐ Fought against the bond bill
- ☐ Voted for appointment of the Superintendent of Education
- ☐ Publicly supported our roads plan. He was designated as the back-up “plan b” to put up an amendment during the roads debate that would make the bill revenue neutral. He worked closely with Quinn, Stringer, and our strong coalition during the debate.
- ☐ He held a live town hall on Facebook to explain the different roads plans and answer questions speaking favorably of our side.
- ☐ Stood with us in press conference to use \$400M to pay down debt, pay to roads, or return to taxpayers.
- ☐ Voted to take down the flag.
- ☐ Note: He was not in office for the legislative pay raise vote
- ☐ Note: He did not vote for our Work Force plan. Stated that he wanted that money to be spent on roads.

**OPPONENT :** Currently, Rep. Collins does not have a formal opponent. It has been stated publicly (to many sources) that Rick Tate will be running against Rep. Collins based on his support of the Governor’s road proposal and that an infrastructure bill was not passed last session. Tate has also publicly attacked Rep. Collins for his support for taking the flag down. Rep. Collins defeated Rick Tate in the 2014 Primary.
