Description/Significant Features: Road 1306.12 (unnamed logging road) dates from circa 1970 and connects Roads 1306.01 and 1306.07, extending 1.63 mile northwest/southeast through the eastern portion of the project tract (see Figures 3.21 and 3.22). Road 1306.12 extends through wetlands and along its entire course the roadbed is flanked by ditches. Road 1306.12 follows a levee and averages 15 ft wide and averages 15-20 ft amsl elevation. Its surface is an aggregate of dirt and gravel.

Historical Information: These investigations identified 14 roads associated with Watson Hill's logging era, circa 1925-2006. These include seven historic roads (Roads 1306.08-1306.14) and seven non-historic roads (Roads A-G). These roads were developed by logging enterprises in the early to mid-twentieth century to facilitate silvicultural activities at Watson Hill.

The USGS (1973) aerial and USGS (1980) topographic map show Road 1306.12 integrated into the logging road network.
